

# Work Notice Schlage Operable Unit (OU) and UPC OU 2401 and 2555 Bayshore Boulevard San Francisco, CA



# Fieldwork Beginning the week of October 4, 2010

## **Purpose of this Work Notice:**

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is distributing this notice to inform the community about upcoming work at the Schlage Operable unit (OU) and UPC OU (Site), located at 2401 and 2555 Bayshore Boulevard, San Francisco, CA. Ongoing soil testing has revealed the presence of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) in soil at the Site in areas not previously treated for contamination.

## **Project Update:**

Initial excavation and treatment of soil at the Site was successfully completed as described in the Site's Remedial Action Plan (RAP), which DTSC approved on November 16, 2009. Follow up testing for soil gas in a northern portion of the Site and areas previously covered with concrete slabs found VOCs above cleanup levels. As a result, soil in these areas will be excavated and treated. Further testing of soil gas will be done after work is completed to make sure cleanup goals are met.

### What work will be done?

The work will consist of digging up and treating about 20,000 cubic yards of soil. This work is expected to start the week of **October 4, 2010**, and will be completed in about one month. All work will be conducted between the hours of 7:00 am and 6:00 pm, Monday through Friday. Work activities will include the following:

- Excavation and treatment of impacted soil. Soil will be excavated, aerated and stockpiled for reuse at the site. Stockpiles will not be greater than 10-feet high.
- Excavations will be refilled with the treated soil. Trucking in soil will not be needed.
- Soil will be sprayed with water to manage dust. Personal monitoring of workers and perimeter air monitoring will be conducted.
- Workers will be operating heavy equipment and wearing personal protective equipment and safety gear.

There should be no significant dust, disruption of traffic, or other nuisances associated with this work.


